The **EIBA Early Career Network (EIBA-ECN)** was launched at the EIBA 2014 conference in Uppsala with the goal to establish a forum for cooperation among EIBA's early-career researchers. EIBA-ECN scholars are brought together to share ideas, build up networks with like-minded individuals, and discuss research projects with a view to the possibilities of cooperation and collaboration.

Full paper submissions should not exceed 10,000 words, and extended abstracts 1500 words. There are no specific formatting requirements.
