PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Helsinki, the beautiful capital of Finland, is a tourist friendly city. The Helsinki region (Helsinki, Espoo and Vantaa) has an extensive and easy-to-use public transport system operated by the Helsinki region transport (HSL).

It is recommended to get familiar with the Helsinki regional zone structure. Correct zone needs to be selected in a Bus/Tram for buying a ticket. The Conference Venue is in Zone B. See [Link](#) for more information on zone structure.

Tickets can be purchased through following methods:

HSL Ticket Machines: Located at metro stations, tram stops, bus terminals, and other key locations throughout the Helsinki region.

HSL Mobile App: Download the free HSL app (App Store/Google Play) for buying tickets. It is a reliable source of maps for specific routes & walk distances too.

Local stores (R-Kiosks and Alepa): These are convenience stores located throughout Finland where single and day tickets can be purchased for all zones.

- Single ticket: 2,95 € (Valid for 80min)
- 1-Day ticket: 9,00 € (Valid for 24 hours)
- 3- Day ticket: 18,00 € (Valid for 72 hours)

Only blue buses require front door boarding and ticket validation. Other transport (trains, metro, trams, orange buses) allows all door entry without ticket checks. Please buy ticket before boarding as it cannot be purchased on board.

TAXI SERVICES

Helsinki also offers various convenient taxi options! Taxis can be booked on-line, through a user-friendly app, or taxi company could be called directly (Phone numbers on left).

At Airport, taxis could be hailed directly from the station outside the Arrivals Hall. Tariffs are displayed on screen near the Exit door, leading to the Taxi lanes. The station features four lanes: lanes 1-3 are dedicated to Fixu Taxi, Taksi-Helsinki, and Menevä, while lane 4 serves other taxi companies. Pre-booked taxis wait for passengers at the back of the station.

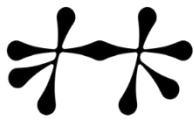

2: Helsinki Airport → Helsinki Central Railway station.

- **Trains** | I and P Trains routes(towards Helsinki Central Railway Station).The train station is located at the airport between terminals 1 and 2. | Operates every 10 minutes -15 mins | 30 minutes Journey| [See Timetable.](#)
- **Bus** | Bus **Route 600** (towards Central Railway Station) |Operates every 10-30 minutes | 40 Minutes Journey | [See Timetable.](#)

3: A) Helsinki Central Railway Station → Aalto University [Undergraduate Centre (Conference Venue) and School of Business (Pre-Conference Venue)]

Metro

- Metro M1 and M2 (Towards Tapiola/Kivenlahti).
- Get off after 5 stops at Aalto University Metro Stop and exit from Metro Exit A to reach Aalto University Undergraduate Center (Conference Venue) and School of Business (Pre-conference Venue). See [Map](#) for directions
- 12-15-minute Journey.

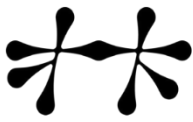
2: Helsinki Central Railway station → Hotels

- I. For **Heymo1 by SOKOS Hotel** | Take Metro M1 (Towards Tapiola/Kivenlahti) | Get off at Keilaniemi metro stop | Walk 600 m to Heymo1 by SOKOS Hotel | 16 minutes Journey | Cost: 2.95€
- II. For **Radisson Blue Hotel Espoo**: Take Metro M1 (Towards Tapiola/Kivenlahti) | Get off at Aalto University (M) | Walk 950 m to Radisson Blue Hotel Espoo or take bus 510 for shorter walk | 26 minutes Journey | Cost: 2.95€
- III. For **Original SOKOS Hotel Tapiola garden**: Take Metro M1 (Towards Tapiola/Kivenlahti) | Get off at Tapiola metro stop | Walk 400 m to Original SOKOS Tapiola Garden | 32 minutes Journey | Cost: 2.95€

TAXI:

1: After arriving at the Helsinki Vantaa airport follow the **directional signage for Taxis**.

2: Hire a Taxi from Helsinki-Vantaa Airport to the Chosen Hotel/ Accommodation (Hotel recommendations for Espoo) | 22-25 minutes Journey | Cost: 50€-60€

BY TRAM LINE 15 | 10 minutes Journey

- Walk 300 m towards KEILANIEMI(M) (Tram stop).
- Take Tram line 15 (towards Itäkeskus Via Aalto).
- Ride 2 stops and get off at Aalto University(M).
- Walk 300 m towards Aalto University Undergraduate Centre.

When coming out of Metro Station (Exit A) or Walking, Aalto University Undergraduate Centre is the red building on the right on Otakaari 1 street.

BY TRAM LINE 15 | 10 minutes Journey

- Walk 400 m towards OTARANTA/ OTSTRANDEN (Tram stop).
- Take Tram line 15 (towards Itäkeskus Via Aalto).
- Ride 1 stop and get off at Aalto University(M) Tram stop.
- Walk 200 m towards Aalto University Undergraduate Centre.

When coming out of Metro Station (Exit A) or Walking, Aalto University Undergraduate Centre is the red building on the right on Otakaari 1 street.

BY BUS LINE 510 | 14 minutes Journey

- Walk 280 m towards HAGALUND (M).
- Take Bus Line 510 (Towards Herttoniemi (M) via Pasila)
- Ride 3 stops and get off at Aalto University (M) Bus Stop.
- Walk 300 m towards Aalto University Undergraduate Centre.

When coming out of Bus stop (Aalto University(M)) first turn left and then right, Aalto University Undergraduate Centre is the red building on the right on Otakaari 1 street.



FROM AALTO UNIVERSITY UNDERGRADUATE CENTRE → ORIGINAL SOKOS TAPIOLA GARDEN

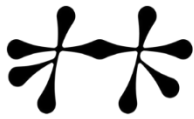

GALA DINNER, 14TH OF DECEMBER, EVENING (7 pm onwards)
VENUE: DIPOLI, OTAKAARI 24.



DIPOLI, a cornerstone building on the **Aalto University campus**, was designed by the architects **Raili and Reima Pietilä** in **1966**. Renowned for its multifunctional spaces, the building serves as a central hub for Aalto University Community. The building has a unique design with bedrock and surrounding forest inspiring the sculptural copper and granite façade. Dipoli is a prominent building of the 20th century modern architecture in Finland.

DIPOLI is a **7 minutes' walk (500 m)** from the main **Conference Venue (Aalto University Undergraduate Centre)** and is located at almost equal distance from all the Hotels as is the main Conference Venue. See [Map](#) for directions.
